SDJH ORCHESTRA CONCERT REPORT FORM

Concert reports are due within one week of attending the concert. All reports need to be in by the Friday before the end of each term. Staple your program to the back of this paper. For full credit, you MUST have a program if one was distributed, otherwise fill out the second page, listing all of the pieces performed. Please do not attach your ticket.

In order to receive credit, the concert you attend must meet the following criteria. Check each box, fits the description:

Performers are performing on violin, viola, cello, or bass for the majority (over 50%) of the concert.

Level of performance is high school level or above. Professional performances are preferable. If the performance involves students who are close to your age, they should be performing music that is significantly more advanced than what we typically play in our orchestra (you would find this in auditioned youth symphonies such as the Davis Youth Symphony, Utah Youth Symphony, etc.).

Check the type of concert performance you attended: String performers must be LIVE, not pre-recorded!

□ Symphony/Orchestra (typical orchestra with multiple string players on each part)

- **Chamber Music** (one person playing their own part in the ensemble)
- Opera (remember string performers must be LIVE, not pre-recorded)
- □ Solo Recital (a soloist performing either alone or with piano a ccompaniment)
- □ Ballet (remember string performers must be LIVE, not pre-recorded)

Musical (remember string performers must be LIVE, not pre-recorded. Also, since this is a popular style (not classical), you may use this type of concert once a year for your concert report)

A band or string ensemble playing folk music, jazz, or music in a more popular style (you may use this type of concert once a year for your concert report)

(Note: If you attend Music & the Spoken Word, this event will count for ½ of a concert since it is only ½ hour long. Please attend two for full credit)
